Observation #1- The army of Israel had lost hope.

- Glancing vs. Gazing?
- The army of Israel was gazing at the giant and glancing at God. David gazed at God and glanced at the giant.

Psalm 27:4
One thing I ask of the LORD,
this is what I seek:
that I may dwell in the house of the
LORD all the days of my life,
to **gaze** upon the beauty of the LORD
and to seek him in his temple.

Observation #2- Why did David choose to gaze at God while the army of Israel gazed at the giant?

- 1 Samuel 17:34-37
- David recalled God's past victories over previous giants in his life.
- No giant is bigger than our great God!
