Will it last for eternity?



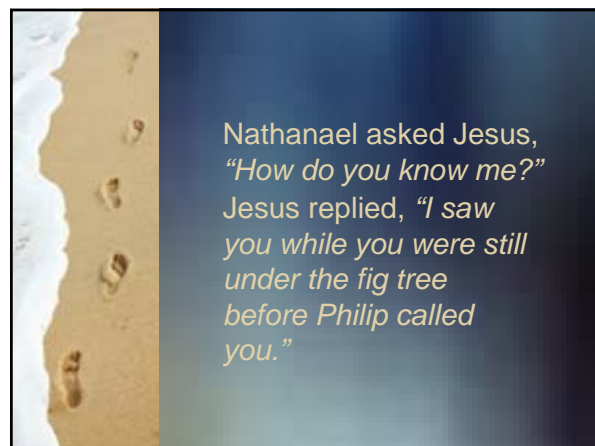
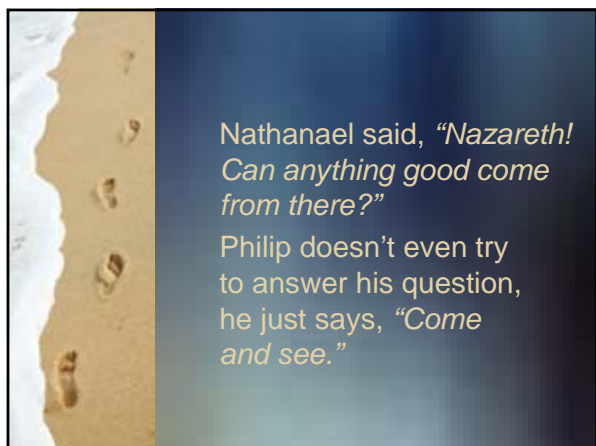
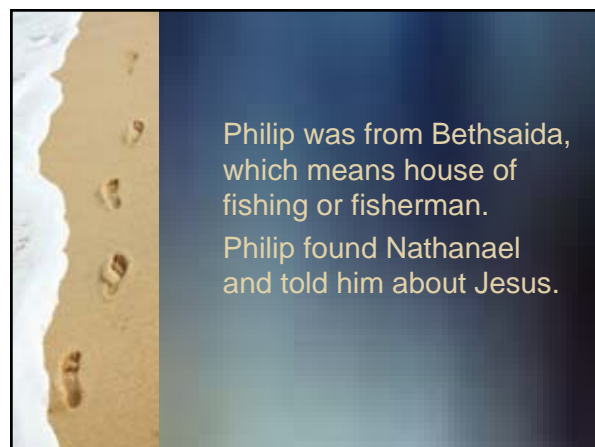
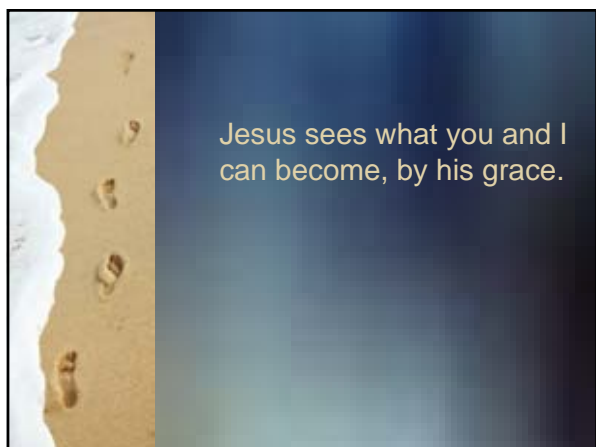
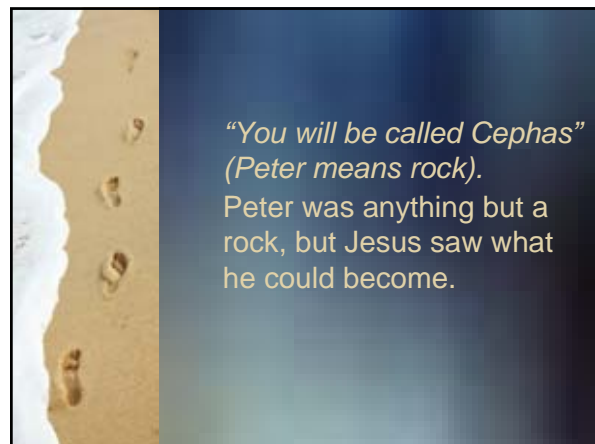
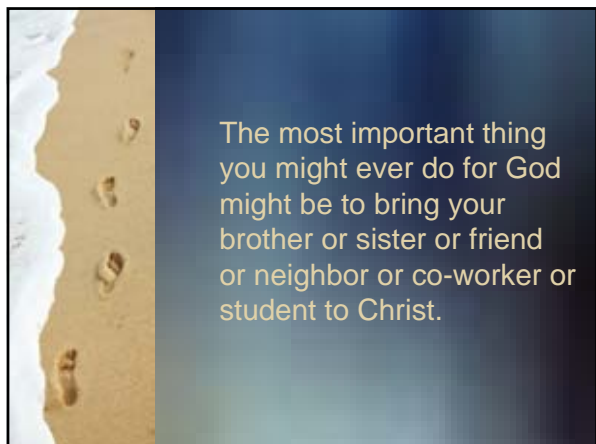
II. Almost everyone who comes to Jesus does so because of a friend or brother or sister.
